



6th Annual DMS Washington DC Trip **Week of June 5-11, 2017**

We are pleased to announce the opportunity for 30 students to participate in a trip to Washington DC in June 2017. Students will have the chance to visit many different sites within the greater Washington DC area:

- War Memorials, Three Branches of Government Sites, US Holocaust Museum, National Monuments, US Pentagon, Arlington National Cemetery, Smithsonian Museums, National Archives, and many other Museums and Places of Interest.

In preparation for the trip, each student will complete assigned readings, documentary films, and conduct research on individuals and/or groups to make their on-site experiences more meaningful and create a chance to make a personal connection to each site.

Students will travel from SLC Airport to Reagan National Airport and stay in a hotel close to the Metro/Subway line. Hotel rooms will be assigned to 3 boys/girls to share, and 6-8 adult chaperones (school staff) will be assigned to rooms on the same floors for supervision.

Preparation for this trip will include 3-4 monthly meetings during iTime or after school, and participation in one group fundraising activity. An additional individual fundraising opportunity will be provided for students to earn their portion of the trip.

The cost will be \$750 per student and is open to both 7th and 8th grade students. Fundraising opportunities will be provided for each student to assist them in earning money for the trip and to offset the overall costs.
