

Utah Immunization Requirements for 7th Grade Entry 2020/2021

To attend the 7th grade in Utah, a student must have proof of receiving the following immunizations:

- 1 Tetanus/Diphtheria/Pertussis (Tdap) booster ***MUST CONTAIN PERTUSSIS***
 - Tdap is required regardless of interval since last dose tetanus/diphtheria (Td) containing vaccine
 - o Kindergarten dose *does not* count as booster requirement for 7th grade
 - o Td without pertussis is not acceptable for this requirement
- 1 Meningococcal
- 2 Varicella (chickenpox) *(or documentation of varicella disease confirmed by your licensed healthcare provider.)

To claim a *personal, religious or medical exemption*, the legal guardian must complete an on-line educational module (free of charge) and provide a copy of the completed form to the school official. The on-line course can be found at www.immunize-utah.org. Completion of the on-line educational module can be done at the Health Department if you do not have access to a computer. For a medical exemption, a written note from a licensed health care provider must be provided along with a copy of the completed on-line educational module. It should state the physical condition of the student, and why that vaccine would endanger the student's life or health.

This record may be turned in now to your **child's current school**, or to the school they will be attending in 7th grade. **Please attach a photocopy of your child's actual immunization record to this form**.
